We just wanted to provide you with a brief recap of the day while you consider attending. The Girl Scouts of FSP go to Camp Lou Henry Hoover-961 Route 521, West Shore Drive, Middleville, NJ

Brownies/Daisy first graders go for the day and 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grade can choose to go overnight in a cabin. Starts with an 1 ¼ hr bus ride leaving at 7am and return home around 8pm.....with a lot of FUN in between.

We schedule 2 crafts for you, games in the play field and a campfire sing-along! We serve you snacks, drinks and dinner...all you need to provide is lunch! Camp Hoover has a lot to do, hiking trails, the waterfront (activities IF lifeguards are present) and of course the search for Miss Mugwump!

All troops need to have one leader "day skill certified" as well as a certified first aider. Camp will have a nurse on duty for the entire weekend.

Day skill certification is an online course that takes about 15 minutes to complete (you actually need this for any trip you take with your troop) go to [www.gshnj.org](http://www.gshnj.org) and click on training, then "Outdoors & Overnights step 1" follow the << in the bottom right corner. When complete, print a copy of the certificate and make a copy for your records as well as for me. Unfortunately, camp fires can only be started **if you are overnight certified**-more on that later.

We talk a lot about "extra moms"...please realize this is NOT a mom & me, I know that the girls are little and some parents are apprehensive about sending the girls out for the day without them. Please reassure them that you are their leader-this is a great time to get out and really learn about them. We understand that there are some medical issues that warrant extra moms coming...that is fine. Just remember you can say no to the "I really want to see what it's about"-you signed up as the leaders-you get the "perks". If you have any problems-refer them to me. As always, refer to safety wise for the ratios....

We will be handing out and telling you much more information as the year progresses.
